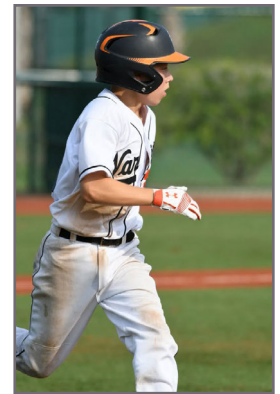

Mission Statement

4. Funding (partial or full) a special trip for Warrior Baseball Teams (ie. Cooperstown, Disney, Perfect Game).



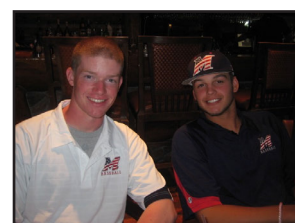
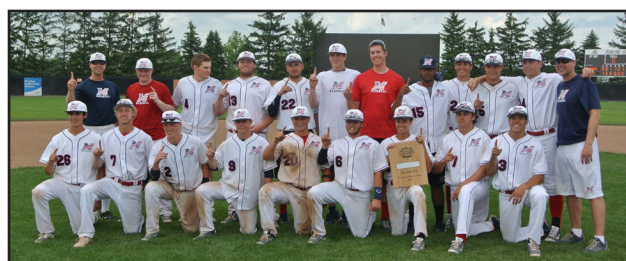
Championship Baseball

Hundreds of travel baseball teams throughout the state of Michigan compete annually in various showcases and tournaments. Many of these programs seek to compete on a national level. Warrior Baseball is certainly no different. But, in 2014, they simply were different, as they became the first Michigan-based organization to win a Perfect Game sponsored National Championship. Led by Head Coach Brian Kalczynski, Warrior Baseball's 'Midwest Elite' took the tournament field by surprise in Fort Meyers, Florida where they won the 2013 17U BCS Finals by compiling an 8-0-2 record, facing the perennial powerhouse East Cobb Astros in the championship game. One summer later, the same Midwest Elite team returned to Fort Meyers, and against all odds, defended their national title, going 7-2 to win the 2014 18U BCS Finals. Midwest Elite finished the season ranked #5 nationally according to Perfect Game, and saw more than 25 players receive a college scholarship.

Warrior Baseball is #1 in the Country!

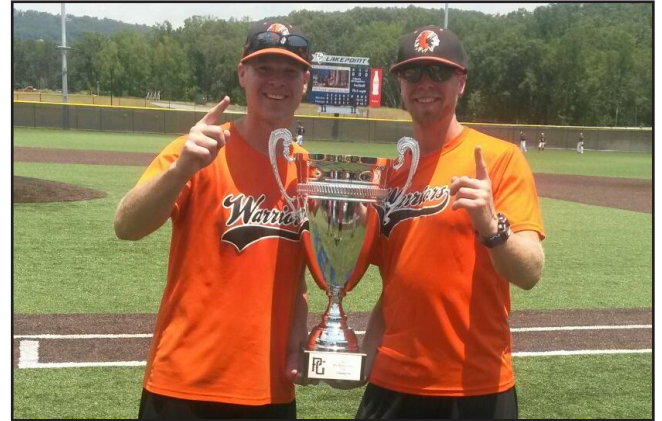
In 2015, Warrior Baseball won the 14U BCS Championship in Fort Myers, FL. Warrior Baseball outlasted Elite Prime (GA) 7-4 in the Championship Game. A few weeks later, Warrior Baseball went to Emerson, GA to compete in the Perfect Game World Series. The Perfect Game World Series invites the top 20 teams in the Country to play for the National Championship. Warrior Baseball did the unthinkable, they beat 3 powerhouse programs to win the National Championship:

Quarterfinal: Warrior Baseball 4 East Cobb Astros (GA) 3

Semifinal: Warrior Baseball 2 MVP Banditos (TX) 1

Final: Warrior Baseball 14 Signature Phenom (CA) 9

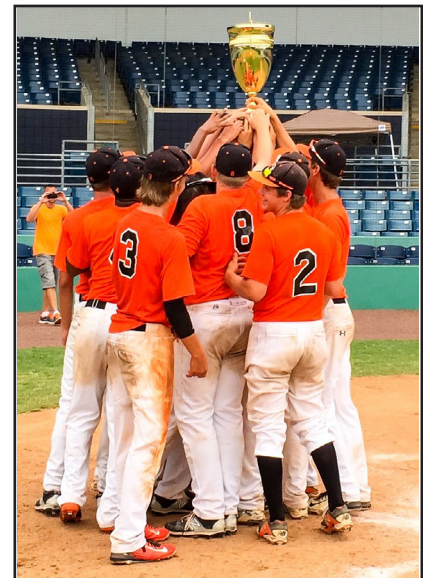
Warrior Baseball ended up finishing 28-3 and ranked #1 in the country by Perfect Game!

Auction Rules

By Participating in the Warrior Celebration Auction each participant (bidder) agrees to the following rules:

1. Items in the auction will use ClickBid. To bid, a person must use their bid number assigned in the ClickBid software. Each increasing bid and the bidder's number is to be entered in the ClickBid software.

3. Tax information: The auction item value listed on your receipt is an estimate of the fair market value. Items have not been appraised unless so noted. The amount you pay above this fair market value estimate is normally tax deductible as a charitable contribution. Please consult your tax adviser to clarify amount of deduction, if any. Values as set forth by item donors may be estimates and are not guaranteed for tax purposes or any other purpose.
4. Restaurant certificates do not include alcohol, tax or gratuities unless specified. Certain services offered in the auction do not include tax or gratuity, unless specified.
5. Payments made by the successful bidder must be paid in full immediately following the live auction. A person may pay express with checking out on a mobile device via ClickBid or with cash, check or credit card.
6. Following payments, you may pick up your purchases in the checkout area. You must show your paid receipt for items to be picked up.
7. The purchaser must pick up all items the night of the auction. Any item left unclaimed, without prior arrangement, will be sold to the next highest bidder and proceeds will go to Warrior Baseball.
8. Warrior Baseball reserves the right to establish a stated minimum bid, the right to reject or accept any or all bids, or the right to add or withdraw any item/service/experience at any time prior to the completion of the auction by the auctioneer.

Bidder Registration

1. All bidders must register and receive a bidder number for use at the silent auction using Click-Bid.
2. Bidders must use their bidder number generated in Click Bid for their bid to be valid.
3. The ClickBid silent auction will be close at 3:00 pm.
4. In the event of a dispute, the auction official shall act as the final authority, and shall determine the winning bidder. The official's decision shall be final.

Live Auction Rules

1. To bid, the bidder must hold their hand high in the air. This must be repeated each time the bidder wishes to initiate or increase a bid.
2. The auctioneer reserves the right to alter the order of items offered in the auction.
